Text: Acts 17:16-34

Title: The God Who is Worthy Of It All

Introduction:

- Underlying all problems, relational, sin, and intellectual problems is a bigger problem a worship problem.
- We forget who the God of the Bible is and our worship turns inward on itself.
- We worship the created things rather than the Creator.

Point 1: Paul is provoked by Idols.(vs. 16-21)

- Paul sees how the people are living around him and how the people in Athens are worshipping FALSE idols and is provoked or angered by it. So he goes preaching anywhere someone will listen!
- He preaches the good news that Jesus died and was raised to life, paying the payment for our sin.

Point 2: Paul Preached a BIG God. (vs. 22-34)

- Following Jesus is more than getting out of hell free.
- Following Jesus means we have a relationship with God. We get God when we come to faith in him.
- God comes down and gets us. Every other religion is work, work, work and maybe the fake god will see us. Not Christianity.
